DAfStb directive:

"Production, monitoring and marking of grout and concrete grout according to DAfStb - Directive" (VeBMR)

Until the introduction of the DAfStb "Concrete Grout/Grout Directive" by the building authorities, grouting products were **non-regulated** building products.

After the introduction of the directive by the building authorities on 15/12/2007, when it appeared in the Building Rules List 2007/2, the products manufactured and monitored in accordance with the Concrete grout/Grout Directive became **regulated** building products.

Since 15/12/2007, only grout and concrete grout may be used for load-bearing building components in accordance with the directive "Production, monitoring and marking of grout and concrete grout according to DAfStb - Directive" (VeBMR). Suitability must be proven by means of a **certificate of conformity (Ü mark)**.

The visible external sign for the introduction and implementation of the DAfStb directive and the associated conversion of the monitoring system for grout/concrete grout to the ÜZ conformity assessment procedure is the marking of the products with the **mark of conformity (Ü mark)** as proof of conformity with the requirements of the DAfStb directive.

The basis for marking the containers with the **Ü mark** is the certificate of conformity issued by a corresponding certification and inspection body recognised by the building authorities.

The following **PAGEL GROUTS** have the certificate of conformity according to the new VeBMR - Directive of the DAfStb.
